

Sundance Equestrian Training Fee Schedule

(all fees accurate as of 1/2014)

All horses coming into our program start at the "A" level of training. Any adjustments made to that program are up to the trainer's discretion.

Training (A): \$700. – Five (5) trainer rides or lessons per week at the trainer's discretion. Includes lunging when necessary and one mane pull & clip per month. Extra clipping will be charged to the Owner.

Training (B): \$490. – Same as above – limited to 3 rides or lessons per week.

Lessons on lesson horses: \$65.00.

Lessons for haul-in clients: \$60.00 Haul-In clients are allowed the same privileges as boarding clients and are upheld to the same rules and regulations. Haul-In clients will be assigned an area in which to park. They are responsible for cleaning any manure/shavings, etc. that are left by their horses/trailers.

Private lessons: \$85.

Ring Fee: Monthly: \$65.00 Daily: \$8.00. Ring fees are not charged to horses that are boarding with us or for haul-in clients on lesson days. Riders wanting to use the arena outside of lessons need to make themselves familiar with the riding schedule.

Length of lesson will be determined by the Trainer, taking into account the skill level, physical fitness of the rider, health and safety of the horse and other factors. Lessons are typically 30-45 minutes long (longer for lessons with 2 or more riders). Riders will be assigned to ride in lessons as determined by the Trainer.

Riders are responsible for making sure necessary and appropriate equipment and clothing is in place prior to their lesson time. Proper turn-out (as defined by the Barn) of horse & rider is required. If Riders are unable to get the horse ready (time required is approx. 15 minutes, depending on skill) & take care of the horse following the lesson (time required is approx. ½ hour), the Rider may choose to take that time out of their lesson time OR they may schedule (in advance) with their instructor to have barn staff do it for them. There will be an additional \$25.00 charge to tack up & a \$25.00 charge to care for the horse following the lesson.

Board

All horses at Sundance Equestrian are engaged in training at some level. We don't accept horses for boarding if the horse is not in training.

Board for horses in training is \$550/month. This includes; stalls with rubber mats, stall cleaning, and feeding 3x/day. Grass and/or alfalfa hay and grain depending on what the Barn deems appropriate. Monthly hot bran mash. Free choice minerals, Equitrol (mandatory) during fly season. Use of tack room, wash rack and riding facilities (schedule permitting). Scheduling of worming, maintenance shots & shoeing. Includes turn out & blanket changes. Appropriate blankets will be requested by the barn & supplied by the owner. We will send blankets/sheets off for cleaning & have the owner billed for cost. If boots need to be put on/off, there will be an extra charge depending on what is necessary. As is customary in the industry, there is a 30-day advance written notice requirement if a boarder intends to vacate. Board is billed as full-month unless a pro-rated exception is agreed to by both parties in writing.

For horses that are part of the program but have to temporarily suspend training, the board is charged at \$600/month. If additional medical or therapeutic care is required, there will be an additional \$250/month surcharge. – includes administration of medication, hand walks or timed turn-out & grooming.
